MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2023-01

IMPOSING PROHIBITION OF THE PASSAGE OF TRUCK (TRUCK BAN) IN POBLACION AREA AT SPECIFIED PERIODS AS PROVIDED HEREIN, INCLUDING THE PARKING THEREOF AND THE STOPPING TO LOAD OR UNLOAD CARGOES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SARIAYA, QUEZON AND PROVIDING PENALTIES IN VIOLATION THEREOF AND OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, every local government unit shall exercise the power expressly granted those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which essential to the promotion of the general welfare, as stipulated on Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Planning and Development Office through a letter dated February 10, 2023 provides proposal for the truck ban hours and window hours within the Poblacion area for 10-wheeler and above trucks;

WHEREAS, as per Section 447(a)(1)(iii) of RA 7160 the Sangguniang Bayan as the legislative body shall “approve ordinances imposing a fine not exceeding Two thousand five

hundred pesos (₱2,500.00) or an imprisonment for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or both in the discretion of the court, for the violation of a municipal ordinance”;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 16 and 447 of Local Government Code of 1991, upon recommendation of Committee on Ordinances and Legal Matters, on motion of Hon. Vince Rudolph E. Alcala, seconded by Hon. Arlene M. Genove, Hon. Demia P. Maghirang, , Hon. Renz Kevin E. Marcuap, Hon. Minerva R. Remo, Hon. Ofelia C. Villapando, Hon. Haydee Medina-Caringal, Hon. Mario M. Medrano, Hon. Francis Joshua L. Alcala, and Hon. Alberto P. Rances be it:-

BE IT ENACTED AS IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF SARIAYA, QUEZON BY VIRTUE VESTED IN IT BY LAW, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. Short Title. – This Ordinance shall be known as the “**Sariaya Truck Ban**”

SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy. – It is the policy of the Municipal Government of Sariaya, Quezon to promote the general welfare and preserve the comfort and convenience of its people. In the pursuit of this policy, any and all activities that tends to prevent or to interfere with it should be regulated and controlled

SECTION 3 – Definition of Terms – As used in this Ordinance the following terms shall be taken to mean as follows:

- a. Banned Vehicles – shall understood to mean 10-wheeler (and above) motor vehicle that carry cargo, including other vehicles such as vans, tankers, or other delivery vehicles whether loaded or empty.
- b. Regulated Roads – shall refer to any alley, streets, roads or any thoroughfare wherein the truck ban shall be enforced as provided herein.
- c. Regulated Period – shall refer to the period within which the truck ban shall be enforced as provided herein.
- d. Truck Ban – shall mean the prohibition of the passage of truck in Poblacion area at specific period as provided herein, including the parking thereof and the stopping to load or unload cargoes.
- e. Window Hours – period of time where trucks are allowed within the Poblacion Area from Monday to Saturday

SECTION 2 – Regulated Roads – it shall be unlawful for banned vehicles to enter and pass, and to park and load or unload cargoes at the following road which are hereby declared as regulated roads, to wit:

- a. General Luna Street/Maharlika Highway/National Highway (Poblacion area)

SECTION 3 – Regulated Period – Truck shall be banned passing to and from regulated roads and to park and load or unload cargoes from Monday to Saturday on the following time period:

TRUCK BAN HOURS

- a. 6:00 AM to 9:00 AM
- b. 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM
- c. 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM

WINDOW HOURS

- a. 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM
- b. 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM

All trucks shall use the Eco-Tourism Road as Alternate Route during Truck Ban.

SECTION 5. Exemptions – The trucks belonging to the following entities are exempted from the truck ban herein, to wit:

- a. The Armed Forces of the Philippines
- b. The Fire Services of the Philippines, National Police and other units responding to fire call
- c. Bureau of Post
- d. The Municipality of Sariaya, Quezon
- e. The Provincial Government of Quezon
- f. The National Government
- g. MERALCO Emergency Crew Truck
- h. Telephone Company repair Crew-Truck
- i. Department of Public Works and Highway

SECTION 6. Implementing Rules and Regulations –The Municipal Mayor, upon recommendation of the Peace and Order Council, shall issue implementing rules and regulations and/or Executive Order, as may be necessary.

SECTION 7. Funding – The appropriation for the implementation of this ordinance shall be included in the Annual Budget and/or Supplemental Budget of the Municipal Government of Sariaya, Quezon.

SECTION 7. Posting of Signs – Upon effectivity of this ordinance appropriate signs shall be posted at all entry points and/or outlets of such road regulated herein informing the motorist concerned about the regulations herein contained.

SECTION 8. Penalty – There shall be a penalty amounting to Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (₱2,500.00) for violation of this ordinance. In case where the violators cannot or fails to pay the fine impose herein, subsidiary imprisonment of not more than one (1) month shall be imposed at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 9. Repealing Clause Any ordinance, rule or regulation, executive order or circular of local origin which is inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. Effectivity This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
