EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 39-2024

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER REORGANIZING THE MUNICIPAL PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL (MPOC) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SARIAYA, QUEZON

WHEREAS, threat to peace and order posed by criminality, insurgency and subversion requires the dedicated efforts of all government official and citizens;

WHEREAS, it is the duty of local governments, the law enforcement agencies, the prosecution services, and similar institutions of government operating in the locality to assist the local chief executive in the proper enforcement of the laws and the administration of justice;

WHEREAS, government efforts at peace and order need to be fully coordinated to effectively prevent and suppress criminality and to maintain public order and safety in the land;

WHEREAS, the participation of the citizenry in peace and order is of critical importance;

WHEREAS, Section 116 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", mandates local government units to establish a local peace and order council pursuant to Executive Order Numbered Three Hundred Nine (E.O. No. 309), as amended, Series of 1988, wherein the local peace and order council shall have the same composition and functions as those prescribed in the said executive order.

WHEREAS, Section 1 (d) of EO 309 provides that the Municipal Peace and Order Council shall be composed of the municipal counterparts of the departments, offices and agencies as enumerated in paragraph (a) of the said executive order, wherever applicable, to be appointed by their respective agency heads, with the Municipal Mayor as Chairman. In addition, there shall be one representative of the Sangguniang Bayan, as the case may be, to be chosen by said Sangguniang from among its members. The Chairman of the Municipal Peace and Order Council shall appoint the three (3) representatives of the private sector, upon consultation with the members of the Council. Departments, offices and agencies with no municipal and/or field offices may deputize their representatives on the municipal levels.

NOW THEREFORE, I, MARCELO P. GAYETA, MAYOR OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF SARIAYA, QUEZON, BY VIRTUE OF THE POWERS VESTED IN ME BY LAW, DO HEREBY ORDER THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION 1. Organization of the Municipal Peace and Order Council (MPOC). The Municipal Peace and Order Council of Sariaya, Quezon is hereby organized on the municipal level of government to be constituted as follows:

- b. To monitor the implementation of peace and order programs and projects at the provincial, city or municipal levels and the operation of Civilian Volunteer Self-Defense Organizations and such other counter-insurgency programs and activities.
- c. Make periodic assessments of the prevailing peace and order situation in their respective areas of responsibility and submit a report thereon with recommendations to the Chairman of the Peace and Order Council, as the case may be, at the national and/or provincial levels.
- d. Perform all other functions assigned by law, the President, or the National Peace and Order Council.

SECTION 3. PEACE AND ORDER SECRETARIAT. There shall be a Sariaya MPOC Secretariat to be headed by the **MLGOO, Ms. Susan Rañola**. The secretariat shall have the following functions and responsibilities;

- Handles the administrative and technical activities of the Sariaya MPOC;
- Undertake liaison work and coordination of Sariaya MPOC with appropriate government agencies.

SECTION 4. COMPENSATION. The Chairpersons, members, secretariat and staffs of the Municipal Peace and Order Council shall be entitled to honorarium of nine hundred pesos (Php 900.00) per quarterly meeting, necessary travelling expenses and allowances chargeable against the funds of the Municipal Peace and Order Council, subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 5. FUNDING REQUIREMENT. The financial requirement of this Executive Order shall be allocated by the Municipal Government chargeable to appropriate source of funds.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY. This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon approval and shall remain in force until it is revoked or recalled.
